
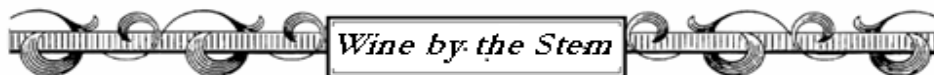

Albariño is a high acid grape that produces lighter body wines. Often brimming with coastal flavors of minerality and sea salt, albariño is a natural match for oysters on the half shell. Those produced in the US are more rare and exhibit fuller body and greater richness.

Arneis, meaning "the rascal" can be a very finicky grape to work with. Found primarily in the Roero Hills, which is northwest of Alba. Medium- to full-bodied wines.

If you're interested in tasting a fuller bodied white other than chardonnay, you may want to try a roussanne or viognier. Indigenous to France's Rhone Valley, viognier offers flavors of dried apricot, peach, & honey.

Chablis is amazing. Few wines around the world elicit the visceral reaction that the word "Chablis" creates. There is a purity of fruit and laser-like acidity that runs through these wines. Chablis always has loads of structure and in many cases, they can age for years. Their salinity and zestiness make for a marvelous palate cleanser or can act as the perfect complement to a plate of briny oysters.

Pascal Clement's Saint Aubin is lovely. Bursting with crisp acidity and showing ample texture. This wine is a little richer than those from Chablis, but not overly weighty.

Francois Carillon's Chassagne-Montrachet has a wonderfully rich texture balanced by the lively acidity. This is a fuller bodied style of Burgundy for those looking for more richness.

Many know Kistler, but do you know of DuMOL? Their Russian River Chardonnay is for those looking for richness combined with structure. Beautiful acidity on the palate followed by deep, ripe fruit with just enough oak. DuMOL is a fantastically reliable producer. Worth every penny.

Hanzell grows and produces chardonnay and pinot noir in Sonoma Valley. They have the oldest chardonnay vines in the New World which go into the "1953 Ambassador's" from select vintages. With notes of citrus-infused melon fruit, apple, and pear, the wine finishes beautifully with bright acidity and magnificent structure which will age very well.

Hyde de Villaine is a joint collaboration between the owners of Domaine de la Romanee Conti and Larry Hyde, one of the top growers in the state. This wine is produced in an old world style but the grapes are California through and through. This is one of the best CA chardonnays I've tasted in a while.

Stony Hill Vineyards, located on Spring Mountain, the moderating climatic influences such as northeast-facing slopes and an elevation between 700 and 1200 feet above the valley floor make this mild microclimate an ideal location for growing premium chardonnay grapes. If you enjoy Old-World chardonnay than this is a must try.

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Pinot noir is often thought of as the most complex red wine grape. It's flavors can range from bright cherry and strawberry in the Carneros and Russian River regions, to the dark, damp, mushroom laced earthiness of Burgundy. Pinot noir, experts maintain, is the easiest red wine to pair with poultry and fish. It possesses an intrinsic softness that allows more subtle flavors in cuisine to shine through.

The Heintz Pinot Noir from the Sonoma Coast has an interesting flavor profile that leans towards the earthy side of the spectrum. Very complex and food friendly.

Lichen's Estate Pinot from Anderson Valley has wonderful spiciness that lasts for a good while on the finish. Tiny production and a real sleeper on this list.

Twomey's pinot noir from the Monument Tree Vineyard is a rarity. They only produced about 140 cases in 2013. This wine is a bit more complex than its Russian River Valley counterpart.

Domaine Serene's Evanstad Reserve is gorgeous. Rip with plush textures and silky tannins, its evident here why Serene is one of the top producers of Pinot Noir in the Willamette Valley.

Philippe Cheron's Chambolle-Musigny is marvelous wine. Plush texture and long, shimmering finish. Young but already amazing!

The Burgundies listed on this page all come from the Côte d'Or, which is divided into the Côte Nuits (north) and the Côte Beaune (south).

The wines and vineyards of Burgundy have a very long history going back to the days when the Romans ruled the region. Relatively medium in body showcasing earth and red fruits. Most Burgundies are very food friendly.

Modern wine-making techniques in the villages of Barolo and Barbaresco often produce full bodied, fleshy, earthy, red wines made from 100% of the Nebbiolo grape. Challenging in the vineyard-these wines are capable of aging for 10 to 20 plus years.

Barolo wines are incredible in their youth but show their true colors with some time in the bottle. For an example of a powerful youthful Barolo, try the Domenico Clerico. Massive with a long and cherry finish, this wine will definitely open up after a few minutes in the decanter.

Nino Negri produces Nebbiolo wines from the Lombardia region of Italy. Situated at the top of Italy just below the Swiss border, the area is very mountainous and the vineyards often must be harvested without any machination. This wine, Quadrio, is soft and elegant with bright cherry flavors. Interesting to note that the local name from Nebbiolo in this part of the world is Chiavanesca. (But its really just Nebbiolo).

Amarone is made from traditional Italian varietal grapes, mostly corvina, that have been dried in the sun before pressing. This concentrated juice produces a rich red wine with port like texture & flavors of chocolate & spice.

Wines produced from the sangiovese grape tend to be medium in body and fresh with higher acids to balance the fruit. The acidity in the wine make it lively and super food friendly especially to cut through with the rich sauces.

The original "Super Tuscan" wine was Sassicaia. In 1970, the Marchesi Incisa della Rocchetta went against tradition and added cabernet sauvignon to sangiovese. This was illegal at the time as the Italian government strictly regulated all wine production. Because this wine didn't fit into their strict laws, it was deemed a vino di tavola, or Table Wine. Decades later, these "Super Tuscan" wines are among the most prized in Italy.

Brunello di Montalcino—translated as "little brown one" from Montalcino—wines are made from a localized clone of Sangiovese and aged for three plus years in oak and in bottle before release. These are hearty and bold wines—think Chianti Classico with much more depth, concentration, and complexity. Brunello is considered to be one of the most age worthy wines from Italy.

Angoris is one of the oldest wineries in Friuli, dating back nearly 350 years. The Pignolo grape produces a tannic, rustic wine with depth, richness, and intensity. Acid and tannins combine to make this a great "steak wine". This is a bona fide hidden gem of Harris' list.

Betz's Besoleil Grenache blend is a lovely composition. Bright and lively on the palate, the wine is a seamless Rhone style blend. It is a bit more fruit forward and ripe than similar wines from the Southern Rhone Valley, but gorgeous nonetheless.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape is a name that even novices have heard of. But do you know where the iconic name came from? In the 14th Century, Pope Clement V, former Archbishop of Bordeaux, relocated the papacy to Avignon in the Southern Rhone Valley. The name literally translates to "The Pope's new castle".

The Bandol from Guilhem Tournier is sourced from 80 year old mourvedre vines that stare directly at the Mediterranean Sea. This is a powerful wine that offers the best of the region. Dry tannins and intense fruit with a backdrop of earthiness. Opens up with each sip, and it is incredibly food friendly.

Portal del Montsant's Santbru is full bodied and rustic, showing lots of fruit. A killer steak wine --and an absolute steal for the money. Total sleeper.

Joan Simo's Priorato is dark and gamey. Great structure and texture and a long, powerful finish.

Porter Creek's Timbervine Ranch syrah is lighter in body and lower in alcohol than many of its CA brethren. But this is not a soft wine by any means. More Northern Rhone than California in style, lending itself as a lovely accompaniment to our lamb chops.

Shafer's Relentless is a masterpiece. Hearty and soul warming. Winemaker Elias Fernandez adds a dose of petite sirah to make it even bravnier and darker. Big, yet balanced.

Cathy Corison produces Cabernet Sauvignon from great bench land vineyards between Rutherford and St. Helena in Napa Valley. Offering tremendous balance with complex berry and plum fruit, enhanced with a mineral note and violet perfume.

Cyrus Creek benefits from the volcanic soils of Calistoga. Lovely minerality and very smooth. This production is limited to just a couple hundred cases each year.

Marc Rafael grows incredibly complex Cabernet grapes at the edge of Oak Knoll, at the edge of Mt. Veeder. Just about 750 cases produced in the 2013. This wine is classic Napa—balanced, elegant, and oozing with terroir!

Pine Ridge produced a very "big" wine in 2013. Dark and meaty with a long dense finish, this Cabernet can stand up to the heartiest of our steaks.

Doug Stanton's family has been growing grapes in Oakville for over 30 years. In 1999, they decided to hold back some of their fruit and to try their hand at winemaking. They believe that making wine from their grapes makes them better growers, that the two are tied together. Great stuff.

ZD was kind enough to open up their library for Harris' and offered up this delicious 2005 Cabernet. Evolved but still very structured, this is a lovely example of a very strong Napa vintage.
